Snuneymuxw (*snu ne mux*): A tribe near Nanaimo, Vancouver Island, British Columbia

Inuit (*in ooit*): Indigenous Peoples of Northern Canada

Inuk (*in ook*): Singular, one Inuit

Kangiqsualujuaq (*kang gi swal i swak*): A community in Nunavik

Nunavik (*noon a vik*): A region of Northern Quebec

Kuuujuaq (*ku tjuaq*): A community in Nunavik

Inuktitut (*i nookte toot*): The Inuit language

Inuit Tapitit Kanatami (*tape re it kana zami*): A national Inuit organization

Nunavut (*noon a voot*): A region in Northern Canada

Inuvialuit (*in u vial uit*): A region in Northern Canada in Canada's western Arctic

Mi'kmaq (*mik mak*): Indigenous Peoples on the eastern Canadian coast

Taba'gan (*taba gan*): Toboggan

Haudenosaunee (*ho den oh SHOW nee*): The Mohawk, Seneca, Onondaga, Cayuga, and Tuscarora Nations who live in northeastern North America

Pemmican (*pemiken*): Beef jerky-like survival food

Haida (*hi da*): Tribe on the west coast of British Columbia

Kwak waka' wakw (*KWOK wok ya wokw*): Tribe on the west coast of British Columbia

Mukluks (*muk luks*): Warm winter boots made of leather and rabbit fur

Siksika (*sik sika*): A First Nation in British Columbia

Sto: lo (*sto lo*): A tribe in British Columbia between Langley and Yale

Salish (*saliSH*): A First Nations in British Columbia

Anishinaabe, Sagamok (*an ishin abe, sag amok*): A First Nation in Northern Ontario
