Tookoolito (*too kool to*): Name of a female Inuit guide

Ipiirvit (*ip iirt*): Tookoolito's husband and an Inuit guide

Attawapiskat (*at uh wuh pis kuh t*): A First Nation in James Bay

Chief Awgeenah (*Aw gee nah*): Chief of the Denesuline First Nation

Denesuline First Nation (*Dene su lee neh*): A First Nation in Saskatchewan

Nuxalk (*Nux alk*): A First Nation near Bella Coola in British Columbia

Nlaka' pamux (*ninqa pamuk*): A First Nation located in the Fraser Canyon in British Columbia

Northern Secwepemc (*Suh Wep muhe*): A First Nation near Williams Lake, British Columbia

Anishinaabe (*an ishin abe*): A group of culturally related Indigenous Peoples from the Great Lakes, Canada and United States region

Peguis (*peg wus*): Largest First Nation in Manitoba

Stswecem'c Xgat' temc (*Sts wecem xgat em*): A First Nation in the Cariboo District of British Columbia

Esk'etemc (*Esk etemc*): A First Nation in the Cariboo District and a subgroup of the Secwepemc tribe

Mohawk (*moe hok*): A First Nation in Southern Ontario

Secwepemc (*Suh Wep muhe*): A tribe in the Cariboo region of British Columbia

Mistawasis Nekivawak (*mas tas ta sis ne hit awak*): A First Nation in central Saskatchewan

Cree (*kre*): North American Indigenous Peoples who live northwest of Lake Superior in Ontario, in Manitoba, Saskatchewan, Alberta, and the Northwest Territories. Some also live in Montana, USA.

Métis (*ma tes*): children of Indigenous and Non-Indigenous parents, mainly Cree and French, Scottish, and English

Coast Salish (*saliSH*): Ethnically and linguistically related Indigenous Peoples of the Northwest Pacific coast of British Columbia including the Lower Mainland, Vancouver Island, and Western Washington and Northwestern Oregon

Katzie (*kat zee*): A First Nation in Maple Ridge, Pitt Meadows area in British Columbia

Musqueam: A First Nation in Vancouver, British Columbia, south of Marine Drive

Guswenta (*ga swenta*): A two row wampum belt of the Haudenosaunee
